## **Information for Contributors**

## **Article manuscripts**

**Review:** Articles are selected by double-blind peer review. The only place your name should appear is on a separate title page; please be sure to remove any self-referencing footnotes as well. If your identity is obvious from the manuscript, it cannot be sent out for review.

**Rules for submission:** Submission of a manuscript implies your assurance that the content has not previously been published in form or in substance, and that the manuscript is not under consideration elsewhere.

Manuscripts may be submitted via Scholastica, our electronic submission system. ([https://submissions.scholasticahq.com/technology-and-culture/for\\_authors](https://submissions.scholasticahq.com/technology-and-culture/for_authors) You will have to create a user id on Scholastica to proceed.) We do not accept hard copy submissions. Email submissions will only be accepted if the author is unable to access the Scholastica system.

We can normally work with files in any common Mac or Windows word processor format, but RTF (Rich Text Format) is usually a safe choice. Do not send a PDF file.

**Length, format, and style:** Our idea word limit for articles is 7,500 words (not including notes) and 100 notes. If you exceed those limits significantly, please consult the editor first; long articles may be returned to the author without review.

Please use a standard font (e.g., Arial, Times) in a standard size (10 or 12 point). Use minimal formatting. Double space everything, including block quotations, notes, and figure captions, and leave adequate margins. Do not embed illustrations or tables in the text; send them as separate files instead.

**Illustrations:** If you wish to propose illustrations for your manuscript during review, these can be uploaded to Scholastica. Do not embed images in the manuscript file.
